Participant Behavior Contract

Good sportsmanship is required of all Orleans Recreation Programs. All players are expected to act reasonably and civilly during activities and not detract from the enjoyment of participation for their peers, teammates, and coaches.

If a participant's behavior disrupts practices or games, the coach or volunteer will promptly notify the Orleans Recreation, Culture, and Community Events Director or the Program Manager. The Department will investigate the issue and respond accordingly. If a "Strike" is issued, it will remain on record for one calendar year. Any child who receives three strikes during this period will be suspended from participation or removed from the current program entirely. Depending on the severity of the behavior, the Orleans Recreation, Culture, and Community Events Director or the Program Manager may determine that suspension or exclusion from the program is necessary after a first offense.

Any participant involved in physical violence or using severe language will be immediately required to sit out for the remainder of the current practice or game. Additionally, they will become ineligible to participate in the next scheduled game.

Unacceptable behavior will not be tolerated. This includes but is not limited to, fighting, hitting, name-calling, bullying, disrespect toward others, refusal to follow instructions, the use of profanity, and any racist or derogatory language. It is imperative that everyone adheres to these standards.
